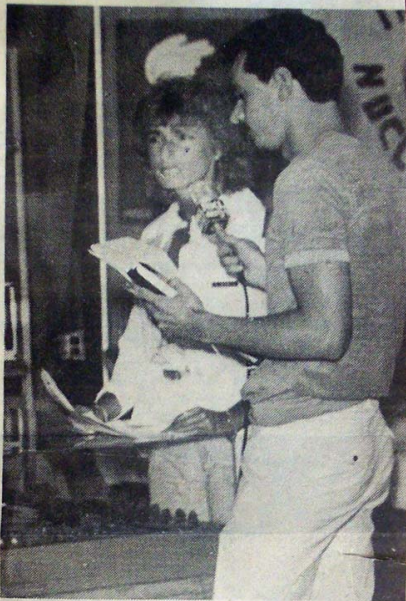


Free blood tests available



Persons preparing for marriage can have their pre-marital blood tests performed free of charge at the Good Samaritan Hospital Blood Bank when they donate a pint of blood. The result of the tests are forwarded by the blood bank to the donor's physician. Each donation entitles donors and their immediate family members to one year of blood coverage. No appointment is needed to give. Interested couples can stop in at the Blood Bank, located on the first floor of the Thomas Building any weekday between 10 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., and Wednesdays until 5:30 p.m. For further information, interested couples can call 357-3300, Extension 2259.
